

# **Application of the Charter of Fundamental Rights of the European Union to the Czech Republic. Protocol (amend.). Consent to not to convene a Convention**

2011/0818(NLE) - 25/09/2012 - Committee report tabled for plenary, 1st reading/single reading

The Committee on Constitutional Affairs adopted the report by Andrew DUFF (ALDE, UK) in which it recommends the European Parliament to approve the European Council's proposal **not to convene a Convention** in order to examine the proposal that Protocol No 30 on the application of the Charter of Fundamental Rights of the European Union to Poland and to the United Kingdom be extended to the Czech Republic. It considers that the effect of that proposal, if any, would be limited.
