

Mobilisation of the EU Solidarity Fund for the financial year 2015

2014/2038(BUD) - 17/12/2014 - Budgetary text adopted by Parliament

The European Parliament adopted by 669 votes to 32, with 6 abstentions, a resolution on the proposal for a decision of the European Parliament and of the Council on the mobilisation of the European Union Solidarity Fund, in accordance with point 11 of the [Interinstitutional Agreement](#) of 2 December 2013 between the European Parliament, the Council and the Commission on budgetary discipline, on cooperation in budgetary matters and on sound financial management.

Parliament recalled that, in line with [Regulation \(EU\) No 661/2014](#) which amended [Regulation \(EC\) No 2012/2002](#), **an amount of EUR 50 million is made available for the payment of advances** through appropriations in the general budget of the Union.

It is recalled that the European Union has created a European Union Solidarity Fund to show solidarity with the population of regions struck by disasters. Therefore, Parliament approved the proposed decision and to include the amounts in the Budget 2015.
