

# Automated data exchange with regard to dactyloscopic data in Denmark

2016/0814(CNS) - 14/10/2016 - Committee report tabled for plenary, 1st reading/single reading

The Committee on Civil Liberties, Justice and Home Affairs adopted, in accordance with the Parliament's consultation procedure, the report by Claude MORAES (S&D, UK) on the draft Council implementing decision on the launch of automated data exchange with regard to dactyloscopic data in Denmark.

The committee recommended the Parliament to **approve** the Council proposal without amendment.

The draft Council implementing Decision aims, for the purposes of automated searching of dactyloscopic data, to authorise Denmark to receive and supply personal data pursuant to [Decision 2008/615/JHA](#) as from the date of the entry into force of this Decision.

In the draft legislative resolution, the committee responsible referred to the [resolution of 10 October 2013](#) on strengthening cross-border law enforcement cooperation in the EU: the implementation of the 'Prüm Decision' and the European Information Exchange Mode and to the [resolution of 9 July 2015](#) on the European Agenda on Security.
