

Automated data exchange with regard to vehicle registration data in Croatia

2017/0801(CNS) - 27/04/2017 - Committee report tabled for plenary, 1st reading/single reading

The Committee on Civil Liberties, Justice and Home Affairs adopted, in line with the consultation procedure, the report by Claude MORAES (S&D, UK) on the draft Council implementing decision on the launch of automated data exchange with regard to vehicle registration data in Croatia.

The committee recommended the European Parliament to **approve the Council draft**.

As a reminder, the draft Council Implementing Decision seeks to authorise Croatia, for the purposes of automated searching of vehicle registration data, to receive and supply personal data pursuant to Decision 2008/615/JHA on the stepping up of cross-border cooperation, particularly in combating terrorism and cross-border crime as from the date of the entry into force of this Decision.

With regard to Article 39(1) of the Treaty on European Union, as amended by the Treaty of Amsterdam, and Article 9 of Protocol No 36 on transitional provisions, pursuant to which the Council consulted Parliament.
