Transport operator: mutual recognition of diplomas, certificates and other formal qualifications (consolidated version)

1990/0479(SYN) - 08/12/1995

The Council adopted a common position on the consolidation of Community legislation on admission to the occupation of road haulage operator and road passenger transport operator and mutual recognition of diplomas, certificates and other evidence of formal qualifications intended to facilitate for these operators the right to freedom of establishment in national and international transport operations.

The common position seeks to establish a real legislative consolidation, involving the repeal of earlier acts. By bringing about greater simplicity and clarity in Community law it can contribute to the creation of a People's Europe .

1990/0479(SYN) - 08/12/1995 - Council position

The Council approved the Commission proposal as such, subject to the following amendments: - integration in the text of Article 5 and Article 10 of the proposal of the time limits for implementation to be observed by the Member States joining the Community after adoption of the directives; - abolition of the time limit for appointment of the authorities or bodies competent to issue documents and certificates; - linguistic amendments to ensure uniformity of the texts. None of these amendments alters the substance or scope of the former directives.

1990/0479(SYN) - 16/12/1993 - Amended legislative proposal for reconsideration

Following the comments of the Council and particularly of Luxembourg in January 1992, the Commission incorporated into its amended proposal Council Directive 77/796/EEC aiming at the mutual recognition of diplomas, certificates and other evidence of formal qualifications for goods haulage operators and road passenger transport operators, including measures intended to encourage these operators effectively to exercise their right to freedom of establishment.

OBJECTIVE: To facilitate exercise of the right of establishment of road transport operators. COMMUNITY MEASURE: Council Directive 96/26/EC on admission to the occupation of road haulage operator and road passenger transport operator and mutual recognition of diplomas, certificates and other evidence of former qualifications intended to facilitate for these operators the right to freedom of establishment in national and international transport operations. SUBSTANCE: The directive consolidates in a single text Directive 74/561/EEC (as amended by Directives 80/1178/EEC, 85/578/EEC and 89/578/EEC) on admission to the occupation of road haulage operator, and Directive 74/562/EEC (as amended by Directives 80/1179/EEC, 85/579/EEC and 89/438/EEC) on admission to the occupation of road passenger transport operator. The Directive represents a true consolidation involving the repeal of the previous acts. By making Community law clearer, it may contribute to the establishment of a 'People's Europe'.
