Textile industry, clothing: methods for the quantitative analysis of binary textile fibre mixtures (consolidation)

1994/0008(COD) - 16/12/1996 - Final act

OBJECTIVE: to codify, with a view to greater clarity and logic, Council Directive 72/276/EEC on the approximation of the Member States' laws on certain methods for the quantitative analysis of binary textile fibre mixtures, a directive which has been substantially amended on several occasions. COMMUNITY MEASURE: European Parliament and Council Directive 96/73/EC. SUBSTANCE: the new directive replaces the various directives which were the subject of the codification operation; it makes no changes at all to the codified texts, restricting itself to reorganizing them and making the formal changes required by the codification operation. ENTRY INTO FORCE: 23/02/97

Parliament approved the common position. The Council was urged in line with its common position, to adopt the act definitively as soon as possible.

The common position is in line with the Commission proposal. The corrections made were purely technical and of no political value. The Commission fully supports the common position.

1994/0008(COD) - 24/01/1994 - Legislative proposal

The aim of this Commission proposal was the legislative consolidation of Directive 72/276/EEC on the approximation of the laws of the Member States relating to certain methods for the quantitative analysis of binary textile fibre mixtures. The new directive was to replace the various directives which were the subject of this consolidation process and would be confined to a compilation of the provisions contained in those instruments, together with the formal amendments required by the consolidation process.

The European Parliament approved the proposal for a directive.

The Council formally adopted the Directive.

The Council agreed to common position. The common position will be forwarded to the European Parliament under the co-decision procedure (Article 189b of the Treaty).

Since this is purely and simply a matter of codifying the existing texts on certain methods for the quantitative analysis of binary textile fibre mixtures, the Council common position makes no substantive changes to the Commission proposal. The codification entails a change in the legal base from Article 100 TEU to Article 100a.
