## **Agricultural products: measures for the benefit of french overseas departments (amend. Regulation (EEC) No 3763/91)**

2000/0307(CNS) - 14/06/2001 - Text adopted by Parliament, 1st reading/single reading

In adopting the report by Mr Miguel Angel MARTINEZ MARTINEZ (PES, E), the European Parliament aims to increase the EU contribution towards regional and agricultural development programmes in the four French overseas territories.

## **Agricultural products: measures for the benefit of french overseas departments (amend. Regulation (EEC) No 3763/91)**

2000/0307(CNS) - 29/11/2000 - Legislative proposal

PURPOSE: to present a Commission proposal for a Council Regulation amending Regulation 3763/91/EEC introducing specific measures in respect of certain agricultural products for the benefit of the French overseas departments as regards the structural measures. CONTENT: the main provisions of the proposed regulation are the following: - the total value of aid, expressed as a percentage of the volume of eligible investments, shall not exceed 75% for investments intended in particular to encourage diversification, restructuring or a shift towards sustainable agriculture on agricultural holdings of very small economic size; - the total value of aid, expressed as a percentage of the volume of eligible investments, shall not exceed 65% for investments in small and medium-sized enterprises engaged in processing and marketing agricultural products consisting mainly of local produce in sectors yet to be defined; - to extend Community financial support for woodlands and areas owned by individuals, associations of individuals, or municipalities or associations of municipalities, to woodlands and areas owned by any public, local, regional or national authority.

## **Agricultural products: measures for the benefit of french overseas departments (amend. Regulation (EEC) No 3763/91)**

2000/0307(CNS) - 28/06/2001 - Final act

PURPOSE : to provide assistance, as regards structural measures, for the French overseas departments. COMMUNITY MEASURE : Council Regulation 1448/2001/EC amending, as regards structural measures, Regulation 3763/91/EEC introducing specific measures in respect of certain agricultural products. CONTENT : The structures of certain agricultural holdings or processing and marketing enterprises located in the French overseas departments show serious shortcomings. these measures are intended to alleviate some of the difficulties. - the Community contribution for all four of the accompanying measures in Regulation 1257/99/EC, which includes agri-environmental measures, will be 85%. - the total value of the aid referred to in that regulation, expressed as a percentage of the volume of eligible investments, will not exceed 75% for investments to encourage diversification, restructuring or a shift towards sustainable agriculture on agricultural holdings of small economic size. - the total value of the aid shall not exceed 65% for investments in enterprises engaged in processing and marketing agricultural products consisting mainly of local produce. The total value of the aid for SMEs will not be more than 75%. - certain restrictions on the grant of forestry support will not apply to tropical forests or wooded areas in the French overseas departments. ENTRY INTO FORCE : the Regulation is binding from 01/01/2000.
