Free movement of persons: national long-stay visa. Initiative France

2000/0810(CNS) - 18/01/2001 - Text adopted by Parliament, 1st reading/single reading

The Parliament approved the resolution by Mr Gérard DEPRez (EPP/ED, B) which welcomes the initiative from the French Presidency concerning visas and free movement. (Please refer to the previous document).

Free movement of persons: national long-stay visa. Initiative France

2000/0810(CNS) - 23/06/2000 - Legislative proposal

PURPOSE: proposal of a Regulation on the freedom of movement with a long-stay visa. **CONTENT:** This draft Regulation constitutes a development of the Schengen acquis within the meaning of the Protocol integrating the Schengen acquis into the framework of the European Union. Because there may be a time lag between the arrival on a Member State's territory of a person holding a national long-stay visa issued by that Member State and the moment when the person receives a residence permit enabling him or her to move freely in the other Member States' territories, it has been decided to take steps to facilitate the free movement of holders of national long-stay visas pending the issue of their residence permits. This would be achieved by stipulating that such long-stay visas, which currently enable their holders to transit only once through the territories of the other Member States in order to reach the territory of the State which issued the visa, are concurrently valid as uniform short-stay visas, provided that the applicants fulfil the conditions of entry and residence laid down in the Convention implementing the 1985 Schengen Agreement. This measure is a first step in the harmonisation of the conditions for the issue of national long-stay visas.

Free movement of persons: national long-stay visa. Initiative France

2000/0810(CNS) - 28/05/2001 - Final act

PURPOSE: to regulate the free movement of third nationals with a long-stay visa. **COMMUNITY MEASURE:** Council Regulation 1091/2001/EC on freedom of movement with a long-stay visa. **CONTENT:** This Regulation seeks to lay down criteria to regulate the movement of third nationals in the EU. According to the Regulation, visas for stays exceeding three months shall be national visas issued by one of the Member States in accordance with its national law. For a period of not more than three months from their initial date of validity such visas shall be valid concurrently as uniform short-stay visas, subject to fulfilling certain criteria. Otherwise, such visas shall merely enable their holders to transit through the territories of the other Member States in order to reach the territory of the Member States which issued the visa. Moreover, visas for visits exceeding three months shall be national visas issued by one of the Member States in accordance with its national legislation. **ENTRY INTO FORCE:** 07.06.2001.
