## Oil and fibre plants: marketing of seed

2002/0105(CNS) - 19/07/2002 - Final act

PURPOSE: to amend Directive 2002/57/EC on the marketing of seed of oil and fibre plants. COMMUNITY MEASURE: Council Directive 2002/68/EC amending Directive 2002/57/EC on the marketing of seed of oil and fibre plants. CONTENT: the amendments introduced by the Council aim to: - include varietal associations of oil and fibre plants species in the scope of Directive 2002/57/EC; - define the conditions to be satisfied by the varietal associations, including the colour of the official label required for packages of certified seed of varietal associations, should also be defined. - include seed of hybrid varieties of oil and fibre plant species additional to sunflower in the scope of certain definitions of Directive 2002/57/EC. Owing to the increased importance in the Community of such seed, the Commission adopted Decision 95/232/EC with the aim of establishing the conditions to be satisfied by the seed of hybrids and varietal associations of swede rape and turnip rape. That Decision expired on 30 June 2002. It is therefore appropriate to keep the Community conditions concerning the marketing of those seeds pending the application of the new provisions. ENTRY INTO FORCE: 31/07/2002. IMPLEMENTATION: 30/06/2003.

## Oil and fibre plants: marketing of seed

2002/0105(CNS) - 14/05/2002 - Legislative proposal

PURPOSE: To amend EU provisions on the marketing of seed oil and fibre plants. CONTENT: The existing 1969 Directive on the marketing of seed of oil and fibre plants does not contain any reference to seeds of a hybrid variety (other than sunflowers) or seed of varietal association. This proposal therefore aims to: - In the case of hybrid varieties, provide a legal basis to include, through a Standing Committee procedure, their seed and - In the case of varietal associations to included their seed in the scope of the 1969 Directive. Such an approach would take into account the increased importance in the Community of this seed.

2002/0105(CNS) - 02/07/2002 - Text adopted by Parliament, 1st reading/single reading
