## Visas: third countries whose nationals are subject to or exempt from a visa requirement

2002/0280(CNS) - 11/02/2003 - Text adopted by Parliament, 1st reading/single reading

The European Parliament adopted a resolution drafted by Jorge Salvador HERNANDEZ MOLLAR (EPP-ED, Spain) and slightly amended the Commission's proposal. (Please refer to the document dated 21/03/03.) Parliament added that Ecuador's inclusion in Annex 1 is a sign of the serious economic situation there. Ecuador should therefore be considered in development aid programmes as a priority objective.

## Visas: third countries whose nationals are subject to or exempt from a visa requirement

2002/0280(CNS) - 06/03/2003 - Final act

PURPOSE : to amend the list of third country nationals who need a visa to enter the Member States and those who do not require one. COMMUNITY MEASURE : Council Regulation 453/2003/EC amending Regulation 539/2001/EC listing the third countries whose nationals must be in possession of visas when crossing the external borders and those whose nationals are exempt from that requirement. CONTENT : due to developments in the international situation, certain amendments are made to the above-mentioned Regulation: - East Timor is moved to Part 1 (States) and removed from Part 2 (Entities and territorial authorities that are not recognised as States by at least one Member State). - Ecuador is inserted in Part 1 - Ecuador and Switzerland are deleted from Part 1 of Annex II. It seems from Member States replies to the questionnaire reviewing the Regulation that that an in-depth review of the reciprocity rule is called for. The Commission will report to the European Parliament and the Council no later than 30 June 2003 on the implications of reciprocity and, if necessary, will present appropriate proposals. The United Kingdom and Ireland are not bound by this Regulation. ENTRY INTO FORCE : 02/04/03.

## Visas: third countries whose nationals are subject to or exempt from a visa requirement

2002/0280(CNS) - 28/11/2002 - Legislative proposal

PURPOSE : to amend Regulation 539/2001/EC listing the third countries whose nationals must be in possession of visas when crossing the external border of Member States and those whose nationals are exempt from that requirement. CONTENT : the European Council in Seville in June 2002 considered as a top priority the review of Regulation 539/2001/EC. The relevant criteria for review are illegal immigration, public policy and security, the EU's external relations with third countries, regional coherence and reciprocity. The new proposal states that: - Ecuador is transferred from Annex II to Annex I on grounds of illegal immigration. Member States will put the visa requirement into effect with regard to nationals of Ecuador by 1/04/03. - East Timor is removed from Part 2 (territorial entities) and added to Part I (States) since it acquired full statehood on 20/5/02 and was admitted to the UN on 27/09/02. - Switzerland is deleted from Annex II. This is because the Agreement on the Free Movement of Persons between the EU and its Member States provides for free movement without visas for the Swiss and for EU nationals. The Commission will report no later than 30/06/03 on the implications of reciprocity and present necessary proposals, if necessary.
