CONTENT: following the accession of ten new Member States to the EU in May 2004, the Council authorised the Commission to open negotiations with the Republic of Kyrgyzstan to update the previously agreed partnership and co-operation agreement by drawing up a Protocol to the PCA. Pending its entry into force, the Protocol has been applied on a provisional basis as from the date of accession. This Decision concludes the Protocol.
