EC/Former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia FYROM agreement: stabilisation and association agreement, protocol after the 2004 enlargement

2004/0115(AVC) - 30/04/2004 - Initial legislative proposal

PURPOSE : to update the Stabilisation and Association Agreement (SAA) between the former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia and the EU following the accession of ten new Member States. PROPOSED ACT : Council and Commission Decision. CONTENT : following the accession of ten new Member States to the EU in May 2004, the Council authorised the Commission to open negotiations with the former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia to update the previously agreed Stabilisation and Association Agreement by drawing up a Protocol to the SAA. The Protocol itself covers certain technical adjustments linked to institutional and legal developments within the EU and seeks to reflect the EU's new landscape following enlargement. The Commission has now completed these negotiations. The proposal includes firstly, a Council Decision on the signature of the Protocol and secondly, a Commission Decision on the conclusion of the Protocol.

2004/0115(AVC) - 22/12/2004 - Legislative proposal

PURPOSE : to enable the 10 New Member States to adhere to the Stabilisation and Association Agreement between the European Communities and the Former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia (FYROM).

PROPOSED ACT : Council and Commission Decision on the conclusion of the Protocol to the Stabilisation and Association Agreement.

CONTENT : in accordance with Article 6 (2) of the Treaty of Accession of the new Member States to the European Union, the accession of these new Member States to the Stabilisation and Association Agreement between the EU and FYROM, which entered into force on 1 April 2004, should be approved by the conclusion of a protocol to this Agreement. This is the aim of this proposal. The text of the Protocol is attached to this decision.

2004/0115(AVC) - 21/02/2005 - Final act

PURPOSE: the taking into account of the accession of 10 new Member States to EU membership in relation to the Stabilisation and Association Agreement between the EC and the Former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia

LEGISLATIVE ACT: Council and Commission Decision 2005/192/EC, Euratom).

CONTENT: This Council and Commission Decision relates to the approval of the conclusion of a Protocol to the Stabilisation and Association Agreement between the European Communities and their Member States, of the one part, and the Former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia, of the other part, to take account of the accession of the Czech Republic, the Republic of Estonia, the Republic of Cyprus, the Republic of Latvia, the Republic of Lithuania, the Republic of Hungary, the Republic of Malta, the Republic of Poland, the Republic of Slovenia, and the Slovak Republic to the European Union.
