## EC/Jordan agreement: Euro-Mediterranean association agreement following the 2004 enlargement. Protocol

2004/0196(AVC) - 07/12/2004 - Supplementary legislative basic document

This document is the definitive protocol of the Agreement between the Union and Jordan following the accession of the ten new Member States.

## EC/Jordan agreement: Euro-Mediterranean association agreement following the 2004 enlargement. Protocol

2004/0196(AVC) - 20/09/2005 - Final act

PURPOSE: The signature and conclusion of a Protocol between the EU and the Kingdom of Jordan taking account of EU expansion.

LEGISLATIVE ACT: Council Decision 2005/0736/EC on the conclusion of the Protocol to the Euro-Mediterranean Agreement establishing an association between the European Communities and their Member States, of the one part, and the Kingdom of Jordan, of the other part, to take account of the accession of ten new EU Member States.

CONTENT: This decision permits the association of the 10 new Member States to the Euro-Mediterranean Agreement between the European Communities and their Member States, of the one part, and the Kingdom of Jordan, of the other part. The protocol also adapts the protocol on agricultural products to the main Agreement and to include the new official languages of the Union in the text of the Agreement.

The text of the Protocol is attached to the Decision with the most important aspect being the inclusion of the new official languages.

ENTRY INTO FORCE: The text of the Protocol negotiated with Jordan provides for the provisional application of the Protocol before its entry into force.

The Protocol will enter into force once the formalities necessary for this to take place have been completed.

## EC/Jordan agreement: Euro-Mediterranean association agreement following the 2004 enlargement. Protocol

The European Parliament adopted the resolution drafted by Elmar **BROK** (EPP-ED, DE) and gave its assent to the conclusion of the Protocol of the Agreement with Jordan.

## EC/Jordan agreement: Euro-Mediterranean association agreement following the 2004 enlargement. Protocol

2004/0196(AVC) - 13/06/2005 - Legislative proposal

PURPOSE: to include the 10 new Member States in the Euro-Mediterranean Association Agreement between the European Union and the Kingdom of Jordan.

PROPOSED ACT: Council Decision.

CONTENT: according to the terms of Article 6(2) of the Act of Accession of the new EU Member States to the EU, accession of the new EU Member States to the Euro-Mediterranean Association Agreement is to be agreed by means of a protocol to this Agreement. This is the aim of this proposal which uses a specific and simplified procedure whereby the protocol is to be concluded by the Council acting unanimously on behalf of the Member States, and by the third country concerned. This procedure is without prejudice to the Community's own competences.

The text of the protocol negotiated with Jordan is attached. The most important aspects of the protocol are provision for the accession of the new Member States to the EU-Jordan Association Agreement and inclusion of the new official languages of the EU. Lastly, it should be noted that the European Parliament will be called upon to give its assent to the conclusion of this Protocol.
