**Agricultural products: applying rules of competition to the production and trade (Council Regulations 26 and 49 of 1962). Codified version**

2005/0231(CNS) - 01/12/2005 - Legislative proposal

PURPOSE : legislative codification.

PROPOSED ACT : Council Regulation.

CONTENT : the purpose of this proposal is to undertake a codification of Council Regulation No 26 of 4 April 1962 applying certain rules of competition to production of and trade in agricultural products. The new Regulation will supersede the various acts incorporated in it. This proposal fully preserves the content of the acts being codified and hence does no more than bringing them together with only such formal amendments as are required by the codification exercise itself.

## **Agricultural products: applying rules of competition to the production and trade (Council Regulations 26 and 49 of 1962). Codified version**

2005/0231(CNS) - 24/07/2006 - Final act

PURPOSE: to codify Regulation 26/62/EEC on applying certain rules of competition to the production of, and trade in, agricultural products.

LEGISLATIVE ACT: Council Regulation 1184/2006/EC applying certain rules of competition to the production of, and trade in, agricultural products.

CONTENT: this Regulation has been adopted in order to codify Regulation 26/62/EEC, which has been amended frequently.

In addition, this Regulation extends Article 81 and Article 86, (competition and dominant position), of the Treaty to the production of, and trade in, agricultural products – in so far as their application does not impede national organisations of agricultural markets or jeopardise CAP's objectives. This latter provision applies, in particular, to farmers' organisations who rely on joint production or who use joint facilities. The Commission will draw up a list of existing, new or proposed types of aid.

ENTRY INTO FORCE: 24 August 2006.
