## Europol: staff regulations, amendments. Initiative Austria

2006/0804(CNS) - 12/10/2006 - Text adopted by Parliament, 1st reading/single reading

The European Parliament adopted the resolution drafted by Claude MORAES (PES, UK) and rejected the Austrian initiative on amending Europol's Staff Regulations. (Please refer to the summary dated 13/09/2006.)

## Europol: staff regulations, amendments. Initiative Austria

2006/0804(CNS) - 22/02/2006 - Legislative proposal

PURPOSE : to make some changes to the Staff Regulations applicable to Europol employees regarding organisational matters.

PROPOSED ACT : Austrian initiative with a view to the adoption of a Council Act amending Europol's Staff Regulations.

CONTENT : this initiative proposed by the Austrian delegation has two principal aims:

- 1) to amend the Staff Regulations in order to provide for a maximum period of service of nine years under two fixed term contracts for all employees;
- 2) to amend the Staff Regulations in order to regulate the employment relationships of the Financial Controller, of the Assistant Financial Controller(s) and of staff working for the Financial Controller's Office, and the employment relationships of the Secretary of the Management Board of Europol and of staff working for the Management Board Secretariat.

## Europol: staff regulations, amendments. Initiative Austria

2006/0804(CNS) - 04/12/2006 - Final act

PURPOSE: to make some changes to the Staff Regulations applicable to Europol employees regarding organisational matters.

LEGISLATIVE ACT: Council Decision 2006/C 311/01 amending Europol's Staff Regulations.

CONTENT : this Decision, proposed by the Austrian delegation, provides as follows :

- the Staff Regulations are amended in order to provide for **a maximum period of service of 9 years** under two fixed term contracts for all employees;
- the Staff Regulations are amended in order to regulate the employment relationships of the Financial Controller, of the Assistant Financial Controller(s) and of staff working for the Financial Controller's Office, and the employment relationships of the Secretary of the Management Board of Europol and of staff working for the Management Board Secretariat.

ENTRY INTO FORCE: 05/12/2006.
