EC/Armenia agreement: partnership and cooperation agreement, protocol after the accession of Bulgaria and Romania

2007/0041(CNS) - 05/06/2007

The Council adopted a decision approving the signature and provisional application of protocols to the EU's partnership and cooperation agreements with Armenia in order to take account of the accession of Bulgaria and Romania to the EU.

2007/0041(CNS) - 26/05/2008 - Final act

PURPOSE: to include Romania and Bulgaria in the Protocol to the Partnership and Cooperation Agreement between the European Union and Armenia.

LEGISLATIVE ACT: Council and Commission Decision 2008/429/EC, Euratom on the conclusion of the Protocol to the Partnership and Cooperation Agreement between the European Communities and their Member States, of the one part, and the Republic of Armenia, of the other part, to take account of the accession of the Republic of Bulgaria and Romania to the European Union.

CONTENT: the Partnership and Cooperation Agreement (PCA) between the European Communities and their Member States, of the one part, and Armenia ([AVC/1996/0093](#)), of the other part, is a "mixed" agreement, which entered into force on 1 July 1999, i.e. before the enlargement of the Union to include the Republic of Bulgaria and Romania.

The purpose of the Decision is to conclude a Protocol to the PCA to allow the new Member States to accede to the Agreement, in accordance with Article 6(2) of the Act of Accession annexed to the Treaty of Accession of 25 April 2005. This Protocol hereby approved on behalf of the European Community, the European Atomic Energy Community and the Member States.

The European Parliament adopted the resolution by Jacek **SARYUSZ-WOLSKI** (EPP-ED, PL) approving, unamended, the proposed Council and Commission Decision on the conclusion of the Protocol to the Partnership and Cooperation Agreement between the European Communities and Armenia to take account of the accession of the Republic of Bulgaria and Romania to the European Union.

2007/0041(CNS) - 16/03/2007 - Legislative proposal

PURPOSE: to include Romania and Bulgaria in the Protocol to the Partnership and Cooperation Agreement between the European Union and Armenia.

PROPOSED ACT: Council and Commission Decision.

CONTENT: the Partnership and Cooperation Agreement (PCA) between the European Communities and their Member States, of the one part, and the Republic of Armenia ([AVC/1996/0093](#)), of the other part, is a "mixed" agreement, which entered into force on 1 July 1999, i.e. before the enlargement of the Union to include the Republic of Bulgaria and Romania.

A Protocol to the PCA therefore needs to be drawn up to allow the new Member States to accede to the Agreement, in accordance with Article 6(2) of the Act of Accession annexed to the Treaty of Accession of 25 April 2005.

On 23 October 2006, the Council authorised the Commission to open negotiations, on behalf of the Community and its Member States, with the Republic of Armenia with a view to concluding a Protocol to the Partnership and Cooperation Agreement. The negotiations with the Republic of Armenia have subsequently been completed. The text of the negotiated protocol is attached.

The Commission proposes that the Council should conclude the Protocol on behalf of the European Community and its Member States and gives its approval for conclusion of the Protocol by the European Atomic Energy Community.
