Legal protection of computer programs. Codification

2008/0019(COD) - 17/06/2008 - Text adopted by Parliament, 1st reading/single reading

The European Parliament adopted, by 644 votes to 9 with 9 abstentions, a legislative resolution approving, under 1st reading of the codecision procedure, the proposal for a directive of the European Parliament and of the Council on the legal protection of computer programs (codified version).

The report had been tabled for consideration in plenary by Lidia Joanna **GERINGER de OEDENBERG** (PES, PL) on behalf of the Committee on Legal Affairs.

The proposal is approved as adapted to the recommendations of the Consultative Working Party of the Legal Services of the European Parliament, the Council and the Commission.

PURPOSE: to codify provisions on the legal protection of computer programmes.

LEGISLATIVE ACT: Directive 2009/24/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council on the legal protection of computer programs (codified version).

CONTENT: the purpose of this proposal is to undertake a codification of Council Directive 91/250/EEC of 14 May 1991 on the legal protection of computer programs. In codifying legislative acts that have been amended frequently the EU is seeking to both simplify and clarify EU legislation.
