EU/Switzerland and Liechtenstein agreement: trade in agricultural products (amend. Additional EC/Switzerland/Liechtenstein Agreement)

2010/0313(NLE) - 10/11/2010 - Preparatory document

PURPOSE: to conclude an Agreement between the European Union, Switzerland and Liechtenstein amending the Additional Agreement between the European Community and the two countries extending to Liechtenstein the Agreement between the European Community and Switzerland on trade in agricultural products.

PROPOSED ACT: Council Decision.

BACKGROUND: the Agreement between the European Community and the Swiss Confederation on trade in agricultural products (Agricultural Agreement) has been extended to the Principality of Liechtenstein. The Agreement between the European Union and the Swiss Confederation on the protection of designations of origin and geographical indications for agricultural products and foodstuffs has amended the Agricultural Agreement by adding Annex 12. Therefore, the Additional Agreement between the European Community, the Swiss Confederation and the Principality of Liechtenstein also needs to be amended so that the protection of geographical indications also applies to Liechtenstein.

This is the aim of this Agreement.

IMPACT ASSESSMENT: no impact assessment was carried out.

LEGAL BASIS: Article 207(4), first subparagraph, in conjunction with Article 218(6)(a)(v) of the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union (TFEU).

CONTENT: this Commission is proposing to conclude this Agreement between the European Union, Switzerland and Liechtenstein amending the Additional Agreement between the European Community and the two countries extending to Liechtenstein the Agreement between the European Community and Switzerland on trade in agricultural products.

The text of the Agreement is attached to the proposal.

BUDGETARY IMPLICATION: this proposal has no implication for the EU budget.

EU/Switzerland and Liechtenstein agreement: trade in agricultural products (amend. Additional EC/Switzerland/Liechtenstein Agreement)

2010/0313(NLE) - 13/09/2011 - Text adopted by Parliament, 1st reading/single reading

The European Parliament adopted a legislative resolution on the draft Council decision on the conclusion of the Agreement between the European Union, Switzerland and Liechtenstein amending the Additional Agreement between the European Community, Switzerland and Liechtenstein extending to Liechtenstein the Agreement between the European Community and Switzerland on trade in agricultural products.

Parliament gave its consent to the conclusion of the Agreement.

EU/Switzerland and Liechtenstein agreement: trade in agricultural products (amend. Additional EC/Switzerland/Liechtenstein Agreement)

2010/0313(NLE) - 15/12/2010 - Legislative proposal

PURPOSE: the conclusion of an agreement between the European Union, Switzerland and Liechtenstein with a view to extending to Liechtenstein the agreement between the European Community and Switzerland on trade in agricultural products.

PROPOSED ACT: Council Decision.

BACKGROUND: the agreement between the European Community and Switzerland on trade in agricultural products entered into force on 1 June 2002. A further agreement concluded between the European Community, Switzerland and Liechtenstein with a view to extending to Liechtenstein the agreement between the EC and Switzerland came into force on 13 October 2007.

The Commission negotiated on behalf of the European Union, an agreement between the European Union and Switzerland concerning the protection of designations of origin and geographical indications for agricultural products and foodstuffs that amended the Agricultural Agreement by adding Annex 12.

The European Union, Liechtenstein and Switzerland agreed that the Additional Agreement should also be amended in order to take into account the protection of designations of origin and geographical indications.

It is therefore appropriate now to conclude the agreement between the EU, Switzerland and Liechtenstein amending the Additional Agreement, on behalf of the EU.

IMPACT ASSESSMENT: no impact assessment was undertaken.

LEGAL BASIS: Article 207(4), first subparagraph, of the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union (TFEU), in conjunction with Article 218(6)(a) (v) thereof.

CONTENT: with this proposal, the agreement between the EU, Switzerland and Liechtenstein amends the Additional Agreement concluded between the European Community, Switzerland and Liechtenstein with the purpose of extending the agreement between the EC and Switzerland on trade in agricultural products is approved.

The text of the agreement is attached to the proposed decision.

EU/Switzerland and Liechtenstein agreement: trade in agricultural products (amend. Additional EC/Switzerland/Liechtenstein Agreement)

2010/0313(NLE) - 20/10/2011 - Final act

PURPOSE: to conclude an Agreement between the European Union, Switzerland and Liechtenstein amending the Additional Agreement between the European Community and the two countries extending to Liechtenstein the Agreement between the European Community and Switzerland on trade in agricultural products.

NON-LEGISLATIVE ACT: Council Decision 2011/739/EU on the conclusion of the Agreement between the European Union, Switzerland and Liechtenstein amending the Additional Agreement between the European Community, Switzerland and Liechtenstein extending to Liechtenstein the Agreement between the European Community and Switzerland on trade in agricultural products

BACKGROUND: the Agreement between the European Community and Switzerland on trade in agricultural products entered into force on 1 June 2002.

An [Additional Agreement](#) between the European Community, Switzerland and Liechtenstein extending to Liechtenstein, the Agreement between the European Community and Switzerland on trade in agricultural products entered into force on 13 October 2007.

The Commission has negotiated, on behalf of the European Union, an Agreement between the European Union and the Swiss Confederation on the **protection of designations of origin and geographical indications for agricultural products and foodstuffs**, which amends the Agricultural Agreement by inserting a new Annex 12. The EU, Liechtenstein and Switzerland have agreed that the Additional Agreement should also be amended in order to take into account the protection of designations of origin and geographical indications.

The Agreement between the European Union, Switzerland and Liechtenstein amending the Additional Agreement should now be concluded,

CONTENT: with this Decision, the Agreement between the European Union, Switzerland and Liechtenstein amending the Additional Agreement between the European Community and the two countries extending to Liechtenstein the Agreement between the European Community and Switzerland on trade in agricultural products is hereby approved on behalf of the Union.

In accordance with this Agreement, the geographical area of the following Swiss GIs that are protected pursuant to Appendix 1 to Annex 12 also includes the territory of Liechtenstein:

- Rheintaler Ribel / Türggen Ribel (PDO)

- St. Galler Bratwurst / St. Galler Kalbsbratwurst (PGI).

ENTRY INTO FORCE: the Decision shall enter into force on 20/10/2011. The Agreement shall enter into force as soon as the necessary procedures have been completed.
