## EC/India Agreement for scientific and technological cooperation: renewal of the Agreement

2014/0293(NLE) - 04/06/2015 - Committee report tabled for plenary, 1st reading/single reading

The Committee on Industry, Research and Energy adopted the report by Jerzy BUZEK (EPP, PL) on the draft Council decision concerning the renewal of the Agreement for scientific and technological cooperation between the European Community and the Government of the Republic of India.

The committee recommended the European Parliament to give its consent to the renewal of the agreement.

PURPOSE: to renew the Agreement for scientific and technological cooperation between the European Community and India.

PROPOSED ACT: Council Decision.

ROLE OF THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT: Council may adopt the act only if Parliament has given its consent to the act.

BACKGROUND: [the Agreement on scientific and technological cooperation](#) between the European Community and India was signed in New Delhi on 23 November 2001.

This Agreement stipulates that it shall be concluded for an initial period of five years and may be renewed by mutual agreement between the Parties after evaluation during the last year of each successive period.

By its [Decision 2009/501/EC](#) of 19 January 2009, the Council approved the renewal of the Agreement for a further period of five years, until 17 May 2015.

Renewal of the Agreement for five more years would be in the interest of both Parties so as to maintain continuity in the scientific and technological relations between India and the European Union.

It is now necessary to renew the Agreement.

CONTENT: the proposal calls on the Council to renew the Agreement for scientific and technological cooperation between the European Community and India for an additional period of five years.

The content of the renewed Agreement is identical to the current Agreement.

The renewed Agreement takes account of the entry into force of the Treaty of Lisbon and replaces the term "European Community" with "European Union".

BUDGETARY IMPLICATION: the implementation of the Agreement involves a financial envelope of **EUR 70 000** from 2015 to 2020.

## EC/India Agreement for scientific and technological cooperation: renewal of the Agreement

2014/0293(NLE) - 01/10/2015 - Final act

PURPOSE: to renew the Agreement for scientific and technological cooperation between the European Community and India.

NON-LEGISLATIVE ACT: Council Decision (EU) 2015/1788 concerning the renewal of the Agreement for scientific and technological cooperation between the European Community and the Government of the Republic of India.

CONTENT: under this Council Decision, the **renewal of the Agreement** for scientific and technological cooperation between the European Community (now the European Union) and the Government of the Republic of India, for **an additional period of 5 years**, is hereby approved on behalf of the European Union.

To recall, by [Decision 2002/648/EC](#), the Council approved the conclusion of the [Agreement](#) for scientific and technological cooperation between the European Community and the Government of the Republic of India. It is provided that the Agreement is concluded for a period of 5 years and may be renewed by mutual agreement between the Parties. By Decision 2009/501/EC of the Council (4), the Agreement was renewed for a further period of 5 years and is due to expire on 17 May 2015.

The Parties to the Agreement considered that a rapid renewal of the Agreement would be in their mutual interest. **The content of the renewed Agreement should be identical to the content of the Agreement.**

ENTRY INTO FORCE: 1.10.2015.

## EC/India Agreement for scientific and technological cooperation: renewal of the Agreement

2014/0293(NLE) - 08/07/2015 - Text adopted by Parliament, 1st reading/single reading

The European Parliament adopted by 639 votes to 48, with 12 abstentions, a legislative resolution on the draft Council decision concerning the renewal of the Agreement for scientific and technological cooperation between the European Community and the Government of the Republic of India.

Following the recommendation from the Committee on Industry, Research and Energy, Parliament gave its consent to the conclusion of the Agreement.

By its [Decision 2009/501/EC](#), the Council renewed the Agreement for a further period of five years and is due to expire on 17 May 2015.

The Parties to the Agreement consider that a rapid renewal of the Agreement would be in their mutual interest.

It is now necessary to renew the Agreement.

CONTENT: this proposal called on the Council to renew the Agreement for scientific and technological cooperation between the European Community and India, for an additional period of five years.

The content of the renewed Agreement is identical to the content of the Agreement in force.
