Single Resolution Board: appointment of the Vice-Chair

2025/0903(NLE) - 31/03/2025 - Final act

PURPOSE: To appoint the Vice-Chair and two full-time members of the Single Resolution Board.

NON-LEGISLATIVE ACT: Council Implementing Decision (EU) 2025/607 on the appointment of the Vice-Chair and two full-time members of the Single Resolution Board.

CONTENT: The Council decided to appoint Mr Miguel CAR CAÑO SAENZ CENZANO as the Vice-Chair and Ms Slavka ELEY and Mr Radek URBAN as full-time members of the Single Resolution Board. Their term of office is set for five years starting from 1 April 2025.

On 15 January 2025, the Commission adopted shortlists of candidates for these positions and provided them to the European Parliament. The Council was informed of the shortlists on the same day.

On 19 February 2025, the Commission adopted the proposal for the appointments and submitted it to the European Parliament for approval. The European Parliament approved the proposal on 11 March 2025.

ENTRY INTO FORCE: The decision entered into force on the date of its publication in the Official Journal of the European Union, which was 31 March 2025.

Single Resolution Board: appointment of the Vice-Chair

2025/0903(NLE) - 11/03/2025 - Text adopted by Parliament, 1st reading/single reading

The European Parliament approved by 570 votes to 46, with 29 abstentions, the appointment of **Miguel Carcaño Saenz Cenzano** as the Vice-Chair of the Single Resolution Board for a period of five years.

As a reminder, Regulation (EU) No 806/2014 of the European Parliament and of the Council establishing uniform rules and a uniform procedure for the resolution of credit institutions and certain investment firms in the framework of a Single Resolution Mechanism and a Single Resolution Fund, provides that the members of the Single Resolution Board referred to in the Regulation are to be appointed on the basis of merit, skills, knowledge of banking and financial matters, and of experience relevant to financial supervision, regulation and bank resolution.

On 19 February 2025, the Commission adopted a proposal to appoint Miguel Carcaño Saenz Cenzano as Vice-Chair of the Single Resolution Board and transmitted that proposal to Parliament. The Committee on Economic and Monetary Affairs then proceeded to evaluate the credentials of the proposed candidate for the functions of Member of the Single Resolution Board. A hearing was then held with Miguel Carcaño Saenz Cenzano, at which he made an opening statement and then answered questions put by members of the Committee.

Parliament recalled that it is committed to ensuring gender balance in top positions in the field of banking and financial services. All Union and national institutions and bodies should implement concrete measures to ensure gender balance.
