

Mobilisation du Fonds européen d'ajustement à la mondialisation en faveur des travailleurs licenciés à la suite d'une demande de la Suède – EGF/2025/003 SE/Northvolt

2025/0326(BUD) - 30/12/2025 - Acte final

PURPOSE: To mobilise the European Globalisation Adjustment Fund for Displaced Workers in respect of redundancies at Northvolt AB, its subsidiaries, and related 13 subcontractors, suppliers, and downstream producers in Sweden.

NON-LEGISLATIVE ACT: Decision (EU) 2025/2661 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 17 December 2025 on the mobilisation of the European Globalisation Adjustment Fund for Displaced Workers following an application from Sweden – EGF/2025/003 SE/Northvolt.

CONTENT: The European Globalisation Adjustment Fund for Displaced Workers (EGF) aims to demonstrate solidarity and promote decent and sustainable employment in the Union by providing support for workers made redundant and self-employed persons whose activity has ceased in the case of major restructuring events, assisting them in returning to decent and sustainable employment as soon as possible.

For the general budget of the Union for the financial year 2025, the EGF is mobilised to provide a financial contribution of EUR 8,526,322 in commitment and payment appropriations in response to the application submitted by Sweden concerning redundancies at Northvolt AB, its subsidiaries, and 13 subcontractors, suppliers, and downstream producers.

The annual allocation to the EGF shall not exceed EUR 30 million (at 2018 prices), as laid down in the relevant regulations.

The application is considered to comply with the conditions for providing a financial contribution from the EGF, based on the assessment made by the Commission.

ENTRY INTO FORCE: 30 December 2025 (date of publication in the Official Journal of the European Union).

APPLICATION DATE: 17 December 2025.
